Face Masks Medical Exemptions in all States. Australia

It is illegal to discriminate against people with lawful medical exemptions from wearing mask.

You are in breach of the Chief Health Officer directions when you refuse entry or service to a medically exempt person.

Business Organisations, Public Authorities & officers are obliged to make themselves familiar with these medical exemptions.

Such a refusal also breaches the Commonwealth Disability Discrimination Act 1992 and you risk a fine or lawsuit if in contravention of this act

PLEASE FAMILIARISE YOURSELF WITH THE FOLLOWING POINTS.

- 1 People who have medical conditions DO NOT have to wear a mask.
- 2 You DO NOT need a medical certificate stating you do not need to wear a mask.
- 3 Employees who are medically exempt cannot be forced to wear a mask.

- 4 Business owners are NOT responsible for people who cannot wear a mask.
- 5 Medically exempt conditions include, Asthma, Emphysema, Epilepsy, ADHD, PTSD, Anxiety, Panic Disorders, Vertigo, Hearing Problems, Breathing Difficulties, Allergies as such many more.
- 6 No one is required to disclose their personal medical information to anyone.

7 – Signs saying "No Mask No Entry" Are in breach of section 6 & 24 of the Commonwealth Discrimination Act 1992 (and other laws) and should either be removed from premises or state "EXCEPT THOSE WITH LAWFUL MEDICAL CONDITIONS" or a similar disclaimer

8 – Harassment, intimidation, coercion, deceit, aggressiveness are not lawful means of imposing your personal beliefs or opinions about mask upon others.
